A once-off property maintenance fee of R3 800.00 will be charged for each family and will help to cover the following costs:

All materials used in the school:

Annually (1 payment) - 31 December 2017

School fees of R43 500.00 plus the levy of R3 800.00 (R47 300.00)

Paid by 31/12/2017 = R44 935.00

Termly (3 payments) – January, May, September

Paid by 15/01/2018 for term 1 will be R17 751.00 (Includes the property levy).

Paid by 1/05/2018 term 2 will be R14 065.00 (if property levy has been paid in term 1, otherwise usual fees).

Paid by 1/08/2018 term 3 will be R14 065.00 (if property levy has been paid in term 1, otherwise usual fees).

Payment may be made in cash or by EFT. Cheques are regrettably not accepted.
