How would you like to pay your school fees?

Annually (1 payment) - 31 December 2017

School fees of R46 200.00 plus the levy of R4 000.00 (R50 200.00)

Paid by 31/12/2017 = R47 500.00

Termly (3 payments) – January, May, September

Paid by 15/01/2019 for term 1 will be R18 500.00 (Includes the property levy).

Paid by 1/05/2019 term 2 will be R14 650.00 (if property levy has been paid in term 1, otherwise usual fees).

Paid by 1/08/2018 term 3 will be R14 650.00 (if property levy has been paid in term 1, otherwise usual fees).
